The American Translators Association (ATA) administers their exam with paper format. The ATA web site is <http://www.atanet.org/>.

The ATA certification examination tests the language skills of a professional translator.

- Comprehension of the source-language test.
- Translation techniques
- Writing in the target language

DANTES TCOs may not administer the ATA exam. The certification examination is a three-hour, open book exam in a specific language pair (i.e., one specific source language and one specific target language). There are three passages. Each passage contains about 225-275 words in English, or the equivalent in another language. The passages present common translation challenges that may vary from one language combination to another.
