DANTES TCO's may administer the Joint Commission on Allied Health Personnel in Ophthalmology (JCAHPO) exams in paper format only. JCAHPO certifies at four levels and in two specialty areas. Exams are based on research conducted every five years to determine the typical task performed by ophthalmic assistants, technicians, medical technologists, and surgical assistants.
