

North American Technician Excellence (NATE)

North American Technician Excellence (NATE) administers their exams with either paper format or computer-based delivery. The NATE web site is <http://www.natex.org/>.

DANTES TCOs may administer the NATE exams in paper format only. The NATE tests assess a technician's applied knowledge as either an installer or a service technician. To earn NATE-certification, a technician must pass both CORE and a SPECIALTY test with a grade of 70% or higher on each. There are 50 questions on CORE tests and 100 questions on the SPECIALTY tests. Candidates have four hours to complete a NATE test session. Questions represent a range of situations that technicians in a variety of work situations might encounter.
