

National Institute for Certification in Engineering Technologies (NICET)

The National Institute for Certification in Engineering Technologies administers their exams with a paper format. The NICET web site is <http://www.nicet.org/>.

DANTES TCOs may administer these exams. NICET provides nationally applicable voluntary certification programs covering several broad engineering technology fields and a number of specialized subfields. NICET-certified engineering technicians and engineering technologists, as members of the Engineering Team, are involved in the planning, design, fabrication/construction/installation, acceptance, operation, and/or maintenance of products, facilities, and processes. They carry out support functions such as data collection, estimating, plan preparation, proposal preparation, quality control/quality assurance, technical sales, and technical writing.

Engineering technician certifications are awarded at four levels; and require successful completion of a written examination requirement, verifiable work experience as an engineering technician in an appropriate discipline, and a professional recommendation.
