The National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians administers their exams with computer-based delivery. The EMT web site is <http://www.nremt.org/>.

Authorized DANTES/Pearson VUE test sites may administer the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians exams. NREMT's credentialing examinations are administered year round at any of over 200 Pearson Professional Centers (PPCs). Available sites may be viewed by logging onto: www.pearsonvue.com/NREMT/. The registration of EMTs is based on the successful completion of the Practical Examination (prospective examinees should have accomplished this prior to registration).
