Alcohol and Drug Counselor Program (USNCB)

The United States Navy Certification Board Alcohol and Drug Counselor Program (USNCB) administer their exams with a paper format. Please refer to: <http://www.nattc.org/getCertified/certification.asp?oldID=ousncb>.

DANTES TCOs may administer the USNCB Alcohol and Drug exams. In 1990 the Navy joined IC&RC as a member board and is referred to as the United States Navy Certification Board (USNCB). The USNCB has jurisdiction over and may only certify those individuals working in the Navy and Marine Corps drug and alcohol prevention and treatment system. The International Certification and Reciprocity Consortium/Alcohol and Other Drugs of Abuse Inc. (IC&RC/AODA Inc.) requires its boards to adhere to standards for counselor certification. These standards identify knowledge and skills an alcohol and drug counselor should possess and also established levels of competency.
