PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The Department of Defense (DoD) Voluntary Education (VoEd) Program, through the Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support (DANTES) ensures Contingency Area Education Support for deployed military members and those stationed overseas in the USEUCOM, USCENTCOM and USAFRICOM AORs (areas of responsibility).

THE DANTES EUROPEAN ADVISOR:

- ✓ Manages institutional partnerships that provide contingency area education support
- ✓ Coordinates mobile testing opportunities at down range locations
- ✓ Conducts training workshops and attends local education fairs
- ✓ Encourages military components to stay updated on DANTES education programs
- ✓ Obtains feedback from education center staff about DANTES material and operations

All active duty, enlisted, officer and warrant officers, National Guard and Reserve components, in all military services, including the U.S. Coast Guard are eligible to use Contingency Area Education Support services.
